TONE & DNA

Dialogue is minimal, technical, and precise. Decisions are framed as safeguards rather than choices. Power no longer persuades or commands — it **delegates**. Violence is absent; consequence is systemic. The tone reflects a world where governance no longer reacts, but **pre-executes**.

VISION

The Continuity Protocol explores the ultimate temptation of modern governance: replacing fragile human judgment with permanent systemic survival. When continuity becomes the highest value, agency becomes expendable. The series examines how institutions can preserve humanity biologically while quietly phasing out its political and moral presence.

CORE MYTHOLOGY

The Continuity Protocol is a classified international framework activated under existential threat conditions. Its mandate is singular: **ensure long-term continuity of the human species**.

The protocol authorizes:
